

CLOTHING LIST – SIXTH FORM BOYS

All items with an asterisk may only be purchased through Stevensons.

Uniform

- Sixth Form boys will wear a dark charcoal grey suit, with a second pair of trousers.
- Shirts may be white or light coloured (not denim or heavily striped or checked)
- School tie and house tie*
- Plain v-necked sweaters in a single dark colour (e.g. black, grey or blue)
- Dark blue, grey or black socks (not white)
- Black, polishable shoes (no suede shoes or boots)
- If a coat is to be worn it should be a formal, knee-length coat (navy or black only).

Jewellery

- Boys may not wear earrings or have any other forms of body-piercing
- Jewellery must not be worn
- It is recommended that watches, or similar items of any significant value, should not be brought to School.

Games Clothing

New pupils to the School require the following compulsory items with the school insignia.

- 1 tracksuit*
- 1 hoodie*
- 1 blue polo shirt*
- 1 white polo shirt*
- 1 blue round necked t-shirt*
- 1 white round necked t-shirt*
- 2 pairs games shorts*
- 2 pairs navy games socks*
- 1 kit bag*
- 1 pair of trainers. It is very important that fashion trainers are not worn as they do not provide a suitable sole which can lead to foot and ankle injuries.

Name tapes should be sewn into the collars and waistbands of all items of clothing.

Depending on sport choices and/or preferences, pupils may also require the following. Items marked with an asterisk may only be obtained from <u>Stevensons</u>.

- 1 white cricket shirt*
- 1 white cricket trouser*
- 1 pair white tennis shorts*
- 2 reversible (blue/gold) rugby shirts*
- 1 sports vest*
- 1 underskins/base-layer leggings*
- 1 long sleeve underskins/base-layer t-shirt*
 (NB Base-layer items are particularly useful for outdoor sports)
- 1 pair swimming shorts*
- 1 swimming hat*
- Gum shield for rugby and hockey (click <u>here</u> to request information about the School's recommended supplier, Opro)
- 1 pair shin pads for hockey and/or football
- 1 pair rugby/football boots
- 1 pair cricket boots
- 1 pair astro trainers
- 1 hockey stick
- 1 tennis racket

Recent reports suggest that boots containing blades e.g. Adidas Predator range, rather than conventional studs, heighten the risk of ankle injuries amongst children. The master in charge of rugby strongly advises that these boots are unsuitable, and, if possible, boots with a conventional stud system should be purchased.

Additional items for boarders

- 1 duvet
- 2 duvet covers
- 3 bath towels, with loops half way down long side
- 4 coat hangers with bar for trousers
- Sponge bag and toiletries
- 3 dozen spare woven name tapes for the House linen room
- Shoe cleaning kit
- 6 pairs of underpants
- 6 pairs of socks
- 1 dressing gown
- A lockable tuck box is also very useful
- 1 laundry basket/bag
- 1 laundry net, minimum size 60cm x 45cm.
