

St Edward's are collecting any old or unwanted sports kit for the **East Africa Cricket & Educational Foundation**.



In 2014 we managed to collect 63 bags worth of kit, which is now being used by children in **Kenya**.

12 of the schools that **EACF** operate in are hugely **under-resourced**, and an estimated **65% of their pupils** are either **orphaned** or **only have one parent** as the result of **HIV/AIDS**.

Although the charity focusses on cricket, equipment and kit from **any other sport** is also massively appreciated by those who receive it.

If you **donate** equipment and kit, you will be helping EACF to **change lives** through sport and character education.



The **EACF** are looking for:

Cricket Bats: any size or make as long as they are useable

Cricket Balls: child or adult sizes

Stumps: sets of three, preferably with bails

Pads: left- or right-handed for batting and wicket-keeping

Helmets: with grill attached

Gloves: left- or right-handed for batting and wicket-keeping

Footwear: in reasonable condition with laces

Clothing: shirts, trousers, sweaters, hats/caps – all sizes and colours are welcome as long as they are clean and in a useable condition.

Kit is to be brought in before **20th June 2017**. Name tags to be removed if possible.
