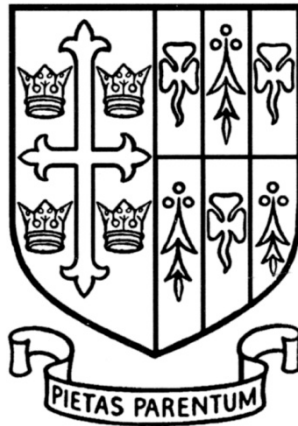

Section 1 (Old Testament)

Question 1

- a. Describe the differences between the two Creation stories found in the book of Genesis. [8]
- b. 'Dominion gives us the right to treat nature as we please.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Question 2

- a. Explain the account of the Flood (Genesis 6-9). [8]
- b. 'The message of the Flood is one of peace.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Section 2 (New Testament)

Question 3

- a. Explain three of Jesus' miracles. [8]
- b. 'Miracles are essential to thinking of Jesus as the Son of God.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Question 4

- a. Describe the temptations faced by Jesus during his 40 days in the wilderness. [8]
- b. 'Easter is the most important Christian festival.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Section 3 (Living Faiths)

Question 5

- a. Explain what Hindus mean by 'reincarnation'. [8]
- b. 'We should aim at liberation from the cycle of life and death.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Question 6

- a. Outline the important events in Muhammad's life. [8]
- b. 'Hajj is the most important of the five pillars for Muslims.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]
