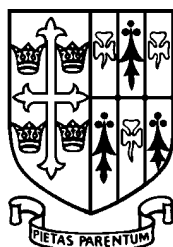

Section 1 (Old Testament)

Question 1

- a. Describe the differences between the two Creation stories found in the book of Genesis. [8]
- b. 'Dominion gives us the right to treat the environment as we please.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Question 2

- a. Explain the account of the Flood (Genesis 6-9). [8]
- b. 'The message of the Flood is one of God's disappointment.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Section 2 (New Testament)

Question 3

- a. Explain three of Jesus' miracles. [8]
- b. 'Miracles are not essential to thinking of Jesus as the Son of God.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Question 4

- a. Describe the temptations faced by Jesus during his 40 days in the wilderness. [8]
- b. 'Easter is the most important Christian festival.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Section 3 (Living Faiths)

Question 5

- a. Explain what Hindus or Buddhists mean by 'reincarnation'. [8]
- b. 'We should aim at liberation from the cycle of life and death.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Question 6

- a. Outline the four most important events in Muhammad's life. [8]
- b. 'Sawm is the most important of the five pillars for Muslims.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]
