#### Question 3

- a. Describe the events surrounding the resurrection, and explain their significance for Christians. [8]

#### Question 4

- a. Describe one of Jesus’ miracles (but not his own resurrection) and explain what it shows about Jesus. [8]
- b. ‘Miracles happen in the world today.’ Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

### Section 3 (Living Faiths)

#### Question 5

- a. Explain what Hindus or Buddhists mean by ‘reincarnation’. [8]
- b. ‘Life is full of suffering.’ Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

#### Question 6

- a. Outline each of the Five Pillars of Islam. [8]
- b. ‘Hajj is the most important of the five pillars for Muslims.’ Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]
