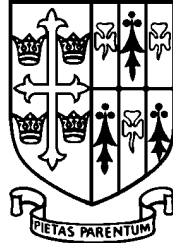

Section 1 (Old Testament)

Question 1

- a. Describe the Creation in Genesis, and explain its significance for Christians. [8]
- b. 'The Earth is ours to do with as we choose.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Question 2

- a. Describe the key events in the life of Job, and explain Job's importance in Christianity. [8]
- b. 'The Old Testament has no value for Christians.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Section 2 (New Testament)

Question 3

- a. Describe the events leading up to Jesus' crucifixion, and explain their significance for Christians. [8]
- b. 'Death is not the end.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Question 4

- a. Describe one of Jesus' miracles (but not his own resurrection) and explain what it shows about Jesus. [8]
- b. 'Miracles happen in the world today.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Section 3 (Living Faiths)

Question 5

- a. Explain what Hindus or Buddhists believe about life and death. [8]
- b. 'Our actions have consequences.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

Question 6

- a. Outline the principles of Islamic worship. [8]
- b. 'Being faithful to God is the most important aspect of a Muslim's life.' Do you agree? Support your answer with reasons, and show that you have considered alternative points of view. [7]

- Answer one question from Part B.
- Your answer should be an extended essay.
- You should spend 30 minutes on Part B.
- You should plan your essay before starting to write it.
