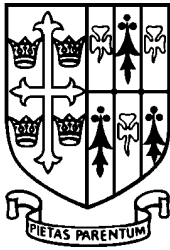

You are to spend 5 minutes planning each chosen essay – this work should also be submitted.

3. 'Criminals should not be able to vote in elections.' Discuss this in relation to the idea of justice.
