St Edward's Proposed Tour Schedule

It is essential to the development of sport at St Edward's that the opportunity to tour is made available to as many pupils as possible during their time at school. The key aim of any sports tour is to give the pupils a valid and valuable life experience. The associated benefits of touring include being able to devote time and energy to conditioning and skills training as well as to compete against overseas opponents. In addition, touring will give squads the potential to improve results (win/loss ratio) in post tour matches. There is also a unity/bonding of teams after experiencing conditions in what are often difficult and testing environments. Touring should not focus solely on the sport and itineraries should include cultural opportunities and, where possible, touring parties should engage in a local project.
