Living expenses






### **Tuition Fees**

- £6,000 £9,250 per year
- Exceptions: BMBS Medicine and courses with a year abroad or a year in industry
- Fees don't need to be paid up front




# Other support from the University of Exeter

- This varies for other forms of financial support


