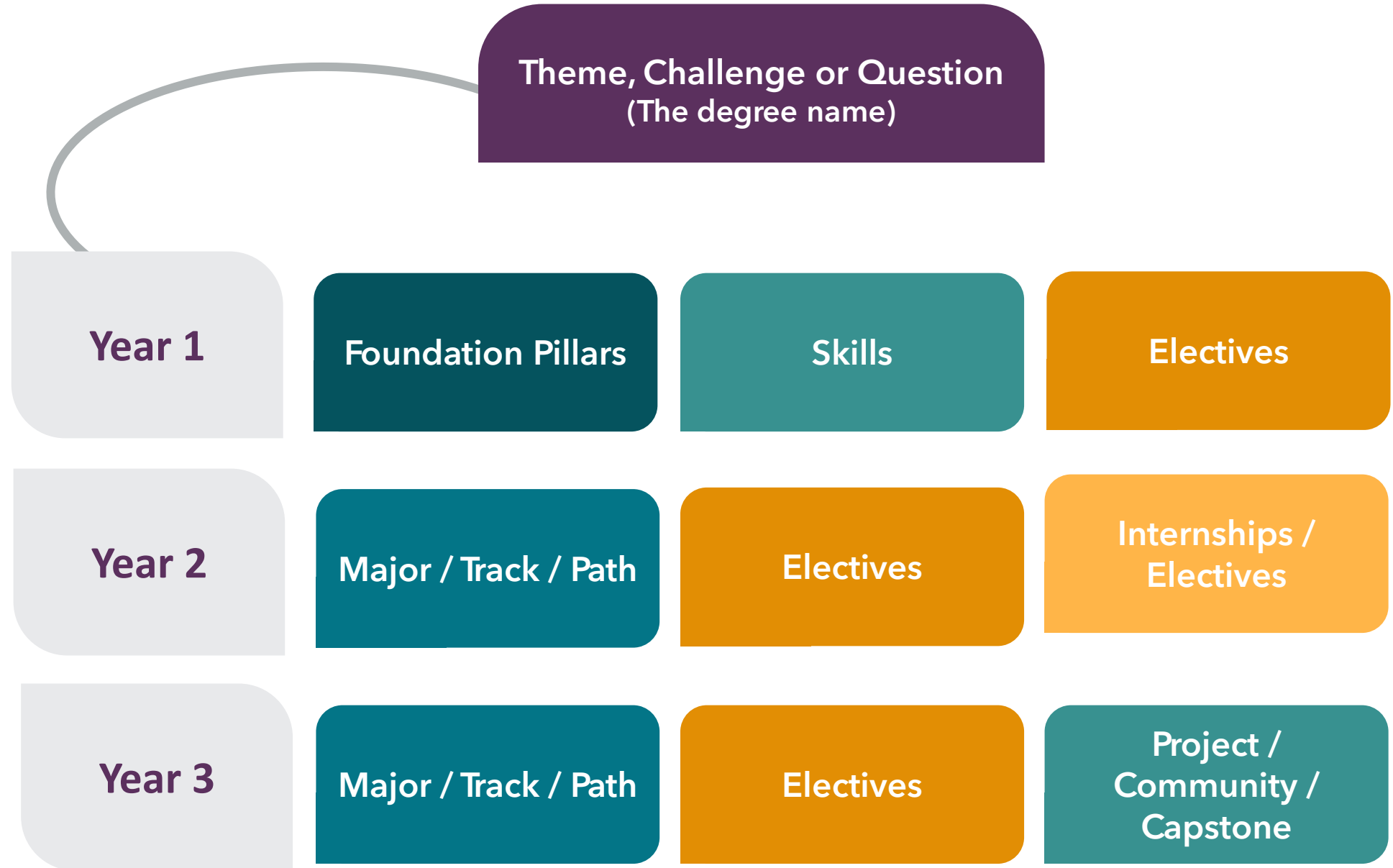

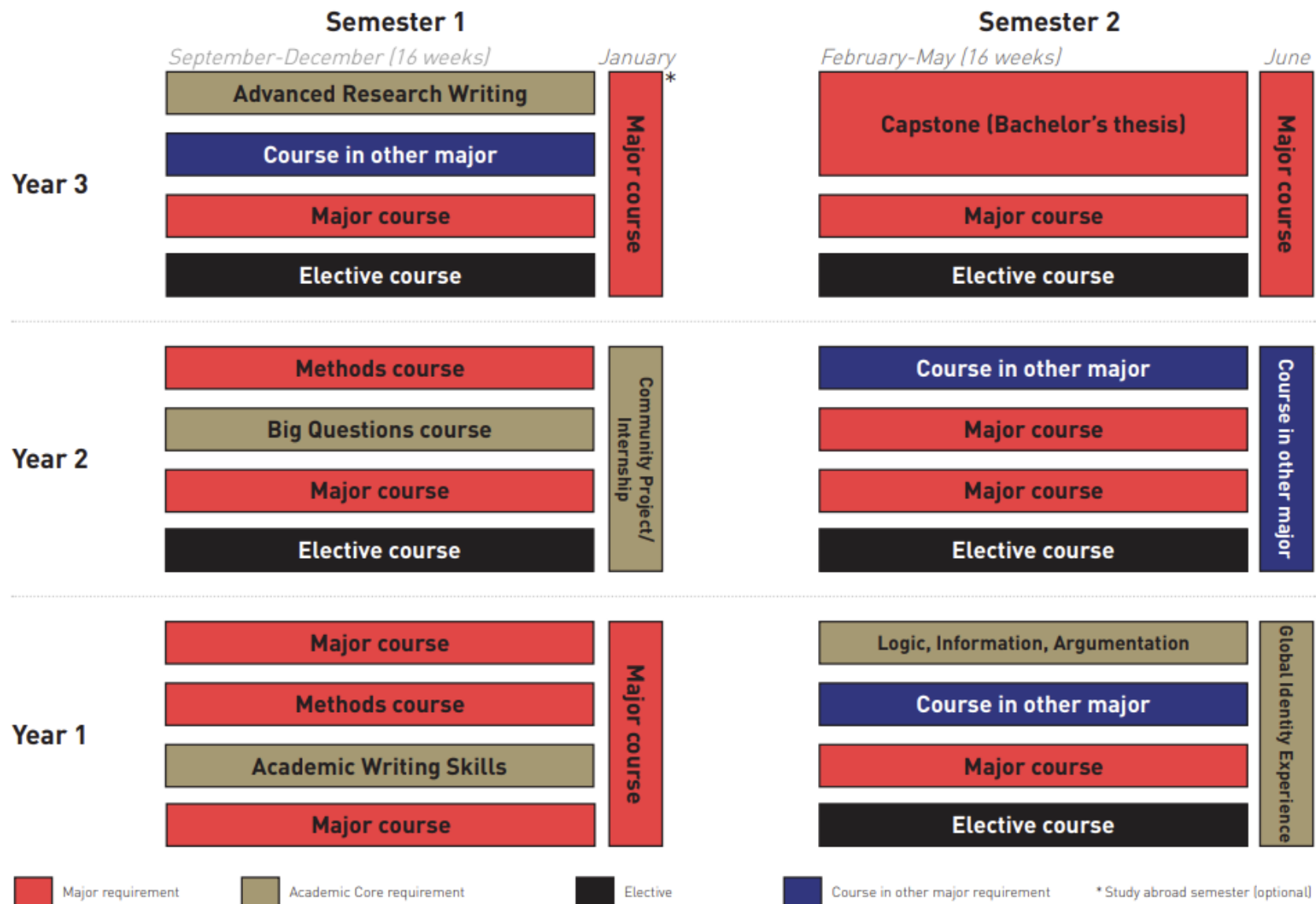

AUC sample curriculum overview

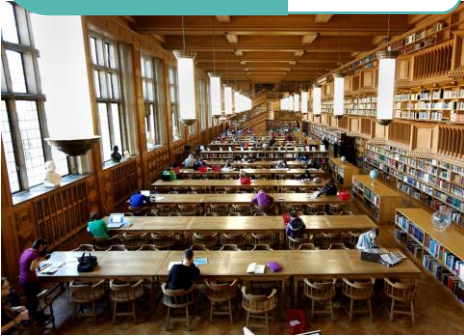
Academic Core (36 credits), Major (90 credits), Electives (30 credits), Courses in other majors (24 credits)

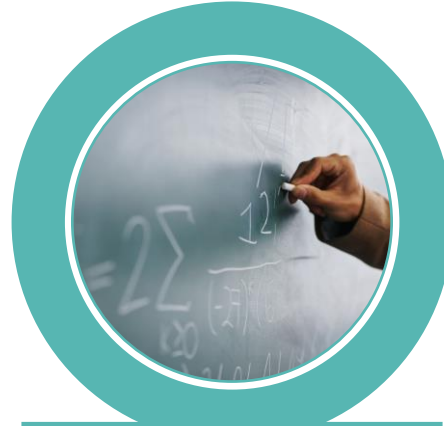

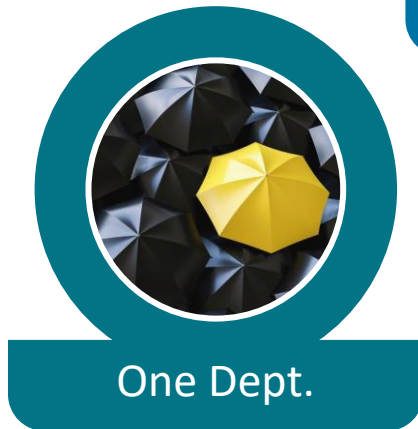

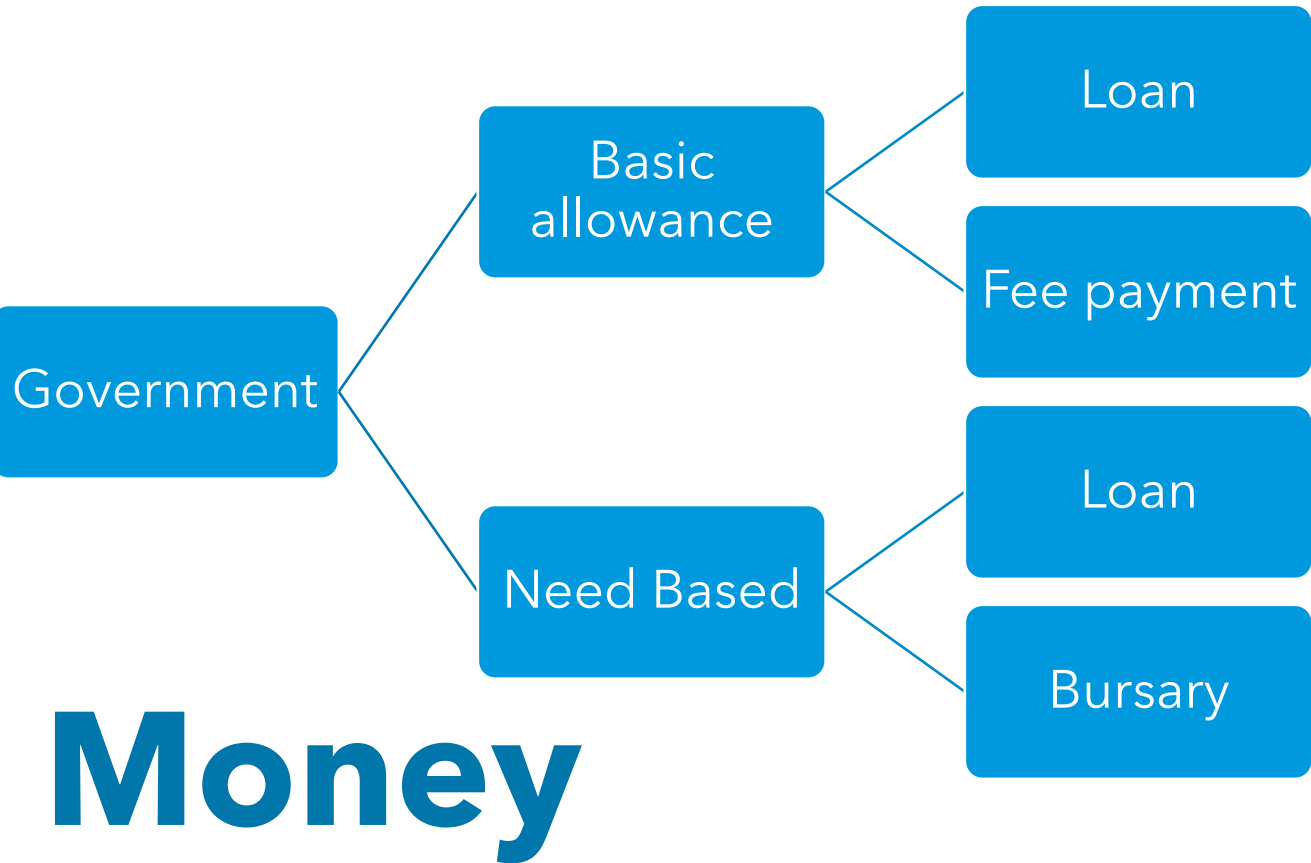

Admissions Approaches



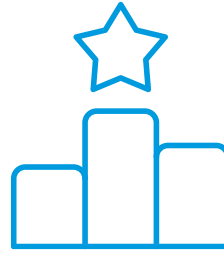
Holistic: Admit to Institution

Consideration of academic history, extracurriculars, contribution to community etc.



Holistic: Admit to Program

Consideration of academic suitability for program, extracurriculars, contribution to course and wider community etc.



Selective: Admit by rank

Review of academic grades against the rest of the applicant pool.



Selective: Admit to Program

Academic qualification (subjects and/or grades)
Alongside motivation for studies and/or aptitude.



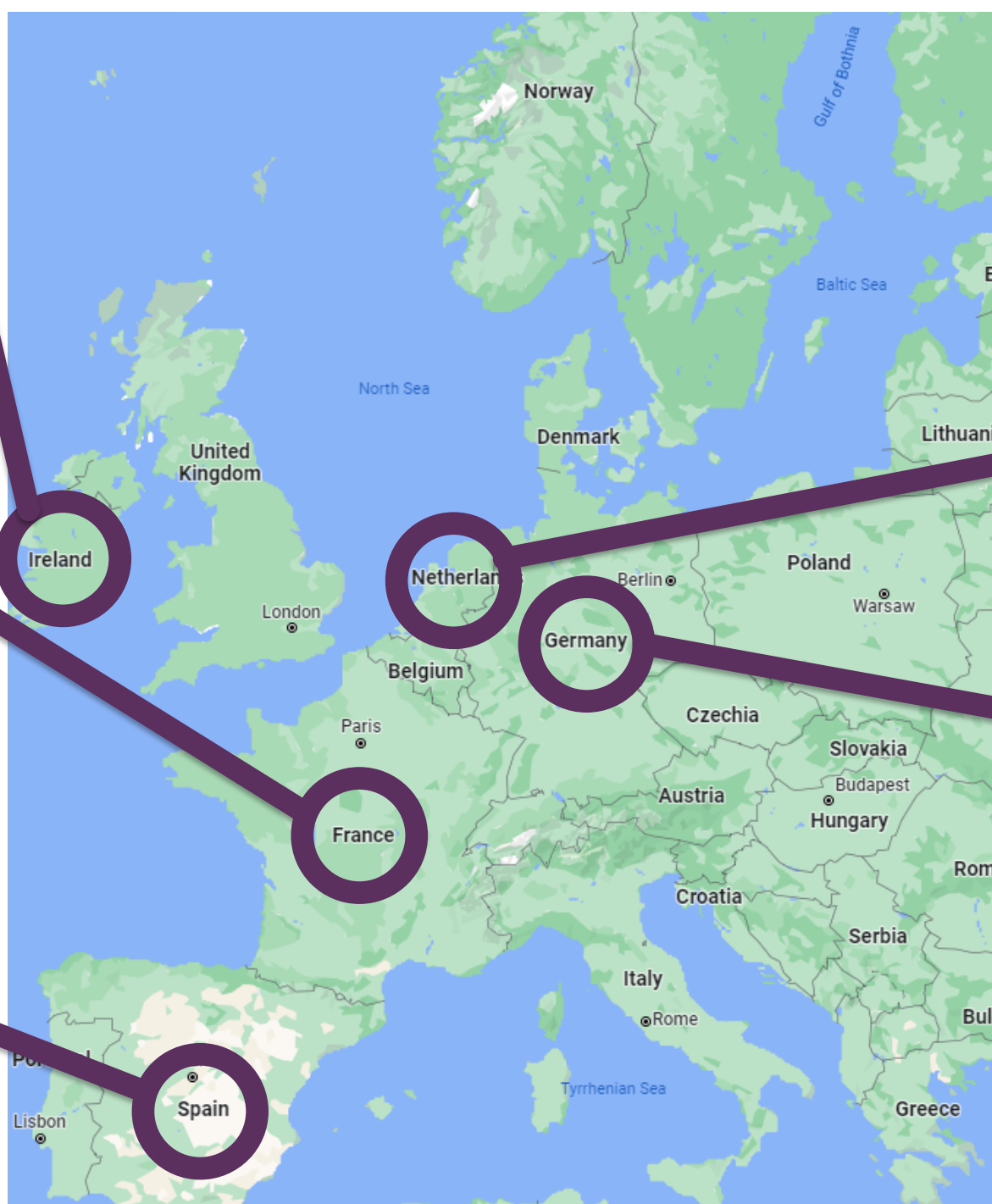
Non-Selective: Admit to program
