

### University of St Andrews

- **Course:** MA (Hons) in English
- **Highlights:** Explores literature from the Middle Ages to the present, with options in contemporary fiction, postcolonial literature, and more. Offers study-abroad opportunities and the option of selecting modules from other subjects.
- **Entry Requirements:** AAA at A-level, including English.
- **International Fees:** £28,190 per year.

### Durham University

- **Course:** BA in English Literature
- **Highlights:** Combines traditional literature studies with contemporary works. Students can engage in creative writing and benefit from the university's strong research focus, including in regular individual/small-group tutorials.
- **Entry Requirements:** A\*AA at A-level, including English Literature.
- **International Fees:** £23,900 per year.

### University College London (UCL)

- **Course:** BA in English
- **Highlights:** Offers a broad curriculum covering literature from the Renaissance to the present, with personalized tutoring and opportunities to tailor the syllabus to individual interests. **NB:** unusually, an interview forms part of the admissions process.
- **Entry Requirements:** AAA at A-level.
- **International Fees:** £29,800

### University of York

- **Course:** BA in English
- **Highlights:** Provides a flexible degree combining historical depth with geographical breadth, including studies in non-English texts. Offers study-abroad options and strong graduate prospects, as well as an in-house student-run publishing house, The Thin Ice Press.
- **Entry Requirements:** AAA or A\*AB at A-level, with a minimum A in English.
- **International Fees:** £25,800 per year.

### University of Exeter

- **Course:** BA in English
- **Highlights:** Covers literature from medieval to contemporary periods, with options in film studies and creative writing. Opportunities for work placements and studying abroad.
- **Entry Requirements:** AAA to A\*AB at A-level.
- **International Fees:** £24,700 per year.

### University of Edinburgh

- **Course:** MA (Hons) in English Literature
- **Highlights:** Offers a cross-disciplinary approach, exploring literature's interaction with society, politics, and identity. Modules include Climate Change Fiction and Medical Ethics in Literature. As with St. Andrew's, the Scottish system also permits the choice of modules from beyond your chosen subject.
- **Entry Requirements:** A\*AA at A-Level.
- **International Fees:** £28,000 per year.

### University of Warwick

- **Course:** BA in English Literature
- **Highlights:** Allows students to shape their degree according to their interests, with opportunities to study abroad in various countries. The Department also retains considerable emphasis on Literary Theory, which has historically been a major research area for the university.
- **Entry Requirements:** AAA at A-level, including English Literature.
- **International Fees:** £23,390 per year.

### Loughborough University

- **Course:** BA in English
- **Highlights:** Ranked 7th in the UK for English in the Complete University Guide 2025, with strong graduate prospects and a focus on student experience. Both year-abroad and placement opportunities are available, as well as an optional additional language course. Optional modules include creative writing.
- **Entry Requirements:** AAB at A-Level.
- **International Fees:** £23,950 per year.
